Dear Christopher Coll:

I received your October 11, 2024 letter, on behalf of Department of Public Service staff (Staff), requesting an extension to comply with the directives set forth in the Commission's *Order Approving Energy Affordability Guarantee Pilot* (Order), issued August 15, 2024, in the above-referenced proceeding. The filing is due October 15, 2024.

You note that the Order directs Staff to file an Implementation Plan for the Energy Affordability Guarantee Pilot (Pilot) that outlines the Pilot's operational details and associated milestones and is developed in consultation with the Joint Utilities and the New York State Energy Research and Development Authority. You state that Staff is developing the necessary implementation workstreams but needs additional time to finalize important operational details with the Joint Utilities and NYSERDA.

Based on the information you provided, an extension, until November 15, 2024, is granted to Staff to comply with the directives noted above and set forth in the Order. This extension is granted to promote the fair, orderly, and efficient conduct of this proceeding.
