Dear Nikolai Wolfe:

I received your June 10, 2024 letter, on behalf of the Joint Utilities, requesting extra time to comply with directives set forth in Ordering Clause 3 of the *Order Approving Statewide Solar for All Program with Modifications* (Order), issued May 16, 2024, in the above-referenced proceedings. Ordering Clause 3 directs each of the Joint Utilities to file a report, by June 17, 2024, that includes their estimated costs for the customer information system and billing system modifications that are needed to implement the Order's directives.

You state that the Joint Utilities request a 60-day extension of the filing deadline, so that they can perform the due diligence necessary to produce accurate and reliable program cost estimates.

Please be advised that an extension until August 16, 2024, is granted to the Joint Utilities to comply with Ordering Clause 3 of the Order. This extension is granted to promote the fair, orderly, and efficient conduct of this proceeding.
