Narrative The North Main Street Historic District comprises 44 contributing buildings, one **Description** contributing object, and two non-contributing buildings along North Main Street, Keeler Avenue, and Oak Hill Road in the Village of Moravia. Contributing buildings are generally modest and high-style residences constructed between 1830 and 1910 and exhibiting typical period styles, including Greek Revival, Italianate, and Queen Anne.

Statement of The North Main Street District represents the period of prosperous post-Civil Significance War development in the Village of Moravia, with the majority of residences in the district having been constructed between 1870 and 1890 in the Italianate Style. The district is listed in the S/NRHP under Criterion C in the area of Architecture for its collection of nineteenth- and early-twentieth-century architecture and compact, unaltered streetscapes.

Narrative The Sherwood Equal Rights Historic District encompasses nearly the entire Description hamlet of Sherwood and consists of 27 contributing primary buildings (primarily, residences), three contributing carriage houses, one contributing cemetery, and one non-contributing building. Resources within the district are located along Sherwood Road and NY-34B. Residences and commercial buildings within the district represent common period styles including Greek Revival, Gothic Revival, and Italianate. One contributing resource, the Slocum and Hannah Howland House at 1781 Sherwood Road, was found to be not extant.

Statement of The Sherwood Equal Rights Historic District is listed in the S/NRHP under Significance Criterion A for its association with reform movements of the nineteenth century, including abolitionism, the Underground Railroad, women's rights, and education; Criterion B for its association with prominent reformer, educator, abolitionist, and suffragist Emily Howland; and Criterion C in the area of Architecture for its collection of residential, commercial, and civic buildings representing period styles of the mid- to late nineteenth century.
