Dear Kai Salem:

I received your April 8, 2026 letter, filed on behalf of Department of Public Service staff, requesting an extension of time to comply with the directives set forth in Ordering Clause 4 of the Commission's *Order Directing Modifications to Tariff Provisions Applicable to Electric Generators* (Order), issued October 17, 2025, in the above-referenced proceeding. The Order directs staff to file a proposal for a standardized methodology to develop balancing charges by April 15, 2026.

You state that additional time is needed to review the companies' responses to information requests; incorporate data from the winter of 2025/2026 into staff's model of financial impacts to electric generators; and draft a proposal reflecting this recent data.

Based on the information provided, an extension, until July 17, 2026, is granted to Department of Public Service staff to comply with the directives set forth in Ordering Clause 4 of the Order. This extension is granted to promote the fair, orderly, and efficient conduct of these proceedings.
