CASE 25-T-0152 - Petition of Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation d/b/a National Grid for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need, Pursuant to Article VII, to Rebuild Portions of the 115 kV Southeast Batavia - Golah 119 Line Traversing the Town and Village of LeRoy in Genesee County, the Town and Village of Caledonia in Livingston County, and the Towns of Rush and Wheatland in Monroe County.

NOTICE OF JOINT PROPOSAL AND OPPORTUNITY FOR PUBLIC COMMENT

(Issued April 9, 2026)

On March 27, 2026, a Joint Proposal was filed by Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation d/b/a National Grid (the Applicant) that was signed by the Applicant, trial staff of the New York State Department of Public Service, the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation, and the New York State Department of Agriculture & Markets. No parties actively oppose the Joint Proposal.

The Joint Proposal contains the terms, conditions, practices, and guidelines recommended by the signatory parties for inclusion in a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need (Certificate). The Certificate, if granted, would authorize the Applicant to rebuild approximately 16.3 miles of the existing 115 kilovolt Southeast Batavia-Golah 119 Transmission Line (Line 119) from a location that is near existing structure 107, west of the North LeRoy Substation, to the Golah Substation (the Project). The Project is in the Town and Village of LeRoy in Genesee County, the Town and Village of Caledonia in Livingston County, and the Towns of Wheatland and Rush in Monroe County.

The Public Service Commission (Commission) may adopt, adopt with changes, or reject, in whole or in part, any of the terms of the Joint Proposal. The Commission also may adopt terms other than those proposed.
