ORES DMM Matter No. 23-03031 - Application of VALCOUR CHATEAUGAY NEWCO, LLC, for a Major Renewable Energy Facility Siting Permit Pursuant to Article VIII of the New York State Public Service Law to Develop, Design, Construct, Operate, Maintain, and Decommission a 116.5-Megawatt (MW) Wind Energy Facility Known as the Chateaugay Wind Repowering Project Located in the Town of Chateaugay, Franklin County, and the Town of Clinton, Clinton County.

NOTICE OF APPLICATION FILING AND
AVAILABILITY OF LOCAL AGENCY ACCOUNT FUNDING

(Issued July 1, 2025)

On June 30, 2025, Valcour Chateaugay NewCo, LLC, filed an application pursuant to Public Service Law article VIII seeking a siting permit to develop, design, construct, operate, maintain, and decommission the Chateaugay Wind Repowering Project with a nameplate generating capacity of up to 116.5-megawatts (MW) in the Town of Chateaugay, Franklin County, and the Town of Clinton, Clinton County. The June 30, 2025, application filing commenced the 60-day application completeness review pursuant to 16 NYCRR 1100-4.1 by the Office of Renewable Energy Siting and Electric Transmission (ORES or Office).

The Chateaugay Wind Project is an existing 106.5 MW wind park. The repowering process would include the installation of new, state-of-the-art technology to increase the generating capacity and extend the useful life of the Project. The Project would consist of the installation and operation of up to 31 wind turbines in the Town of Chateaugay, together with the associated electrical collection system, access roads, laydown/staging areas, and ancillary facilities. The electrical collection system is proposed to pass through the Towns of Chateaugay and Clinton. The Project will use an existing collection substation in the Town of Clinton, point of interconnection switchyard, access roads, and other ancillary facilities.

With its application, Valcour Chateaugay NewCo, LLC, submitted the required local agency account fee of \$106,500. Please take notice that funds are available to eligible local agencies and potential community intervenors for use in contributing to the development

of a complete record leading to an informed decision by the Office as to the appropriateness of the site and the facility, and for local agencies, for use in determining whether a proposed facility is designed to be sited, constructed, and operated in compliance with applicable local laws and regulations.

Local agencies and potential community intervenors intending to request local agency account funding must submit their request for funding by no later than **4:30 p.m. EST on July 31, 2025**. Parties requesting such funding must use the **ORES Request For Local Agency Account Funding** form available in the Resources section of the ORES website at: <https://dps.ny.gov/ores-resources>.

All requests for local agency account funding must register on the party list on the Department of Public Service's Document and Matter Management (DMM) system,¹ consent to electronic service, and electronically file (EFile) the funding request form. Any person unable to consent to electronic service may obtain authorization for alternative means of receiving service upon good cause shown to the assigned Administrative Law Judges (ALJs) Dawn MacKillop-Soller (dawn.mackillop-soller@dps.ny.gov) and Henry James Joseph (henry.joseph@dps.ny.gov).

In addition to Efiling, all requests for local agency account funding must be served on ORES by email to ores.hearings@dps.ny.gov. All requests must also be served by email on all persons on the party list for this proceeding and the assigned ALJ.
