By Notice issued on January 9, 2023 (January Notice), comments were requested on "Department of Public Service Staff Energy Efficiency and Building Electrification Report" (DPS Report), that was filed on December 20, 2022, in the above-referenced proceedings. The January Notice requested such comments by March 6, 2023.

An extension of that due date was requested in letters filed on February 3, 2023, by the City of New York, and on February 8, 2023, by Franklin Energy. Both entities asserted that the Statewide Energy Efficiency & Electrification Potential Study For the Buildings Sector (Study), due to be filed on February 28, 2023, will be useful in determining whether and how the New Efficiency: New York portfolio of programs should evolve, and that additional time is necessary to comprehensively review, analyze, and determine whether and how to incorporate the information and findings in the Study into their comments. In a letter filed on February 8, 2023, The Alliance for Clean Energy New York, Advanced Energy United, Association of Energy Affordability, the Natural Resources Defense Council, New Yorkers for Clean Power, PACE Energy and Climate Center, and WE ACT for Environmental Justice wrote in support of the requested extension.
