Re: Case 11-G-0668, In the Matter of the Rules and Regulations of the Public Service Commission, Contained in 16 NYCRR, In Relation to Complaint Procedures-Appeal by The Brooklyn Union Gas Company d/b/a National Grid of the Informal Decision Rendered Favor of Grenadier Realty (041702), et al.

Dear Secretary Burgess:

Pursuant to Commission Rule 3.3 (16 N.Y.C.R.R. § 3.3), The Brooklyn Union Gas Company d/b/a National Grid (“National Grid” or the “Company”) respectfully requests a 10-day extension to comply with the Commission Determination of May 13, 2014 in the above-referenced case.

In its May 13th Determination, the Commission found that one of Grenadier Realty’s accounts, referred to as “Surf 21,” was entitled to a refund for the billing period from March 2008 to March 2009. The Commission directed National Grid to recalculate the account’s bill for the period at the SC-2 non-heating rate and to refund any overpaid amount, with interest, within 30 days. The refund should have been issued on or before June 12th

The undersigned has been coordinating the Company’s response to the various SC-2 heating/non-heating rebilling cases but was personally unaware the Commission had issued the May 13th determination – and it appears that other individuals at the Company responsible for performing the rate analysis on the accounts were also unaware (we now understand that two orders were issued the same day on this issue). Immediately upon receipt of an email communication from Staff Counsel advising that the Company had failed to respond by the date in the Determination, the Company undertook to gather the relevant data and is currently in the process of performing the rate analysis. The Company will notify the Commission as soon as the appropriate refund, if any, is issued. Because the Company will apply interest on the accounts until the refund checks are issued, the affected customer will not be prejudiced by the delay.
