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APPLICATION TO INTERVENE OF DIRECT ENERGY SERVICES, LLC

Direct Energy Services, LLC ("Direct Energy") submits this Application to Intervene in the above-referenced proceeding pursuant to Rule 3.5 of the Commission's Procedural Rules, 16 N.Y.C.R.R. § 3.5 (2006).

BACKGROUND

On January 29, 2007, National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation ("NFGD") submitted proposed amendments to its rate schedule for natural gas service designed to increase its total annual revenues by approximately \$ 52 million or 6.4 percent, while increasing delivery rates by approximately 19 percent. By order dated February 20, 2007, the Commission suspended these proposed rates and directed that a hearing be held on NFGD's proposal.

INTERVENTION

Direct Energy is a retail marketer of electricity and is a wholly-owned, indirect subsidiary of Centrica plc, a publicly traded company and major supplier of energy and telecommunication

services in the United Kingdom. Centrica, through its affiliates, serves over 15 million natural gas and power customers in the United Kingdom. In North America, Centrica's subsidiaries provide electricity and natural gas services to 3.5 million customers. Direct Energy has received authority from the Commission to participate as an Energy Services Company ("ESCO") in the retail access programs of utilities regulated by the Commission, including NFGD, subject to Direct Energy's satisfaction of the detailed eligibility provisions of individual utility tariffs.

As an ESCO authorized by the Commission to do business in New York State, Direct Energy has a direct and substantial interest in the outcome of these proceedings that cannot adequately be represented by any other party.
