ORDER EXTENDING COMPLIANCE DATE

(Issued and Effective July 1, 2004)

By Order dated May 21, 2004, we required Vonage Holdings Corporation (Vonage) to file a tariff and a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity and any request for waivers of our regulations within 45 days. On June 30, 2004, Magistrate Judge Douglas F. Eaton of the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York stated his intent to stay our order as of July 2, 2004, unless the compliance date of July 6, 2004 was extended to allow Vonage and Staff time to negotiate a preliminary injunction precluding enforcement of our order, but reflecting commitments by Vonage to cooperate on resolving questions about its 911 service. In light of the Magistrate Judge's decision, the deadline for compliance with the May 21, 2004 order will be extended to July 20, 2004.

It is ordered:

 The date for compliance with the Commission's May 21, 2004 order will be extended to July 20, 2004.
