Central Hudson's Recent Filing on Interim Energy Efficiency Programs, Deferral Accounting, Revenue Decoupling Mechanisms and an Interim Economic Incentive

Dear Secretary Brillling,

My company, Hudson Valley Clean Energy, Inc., sells, designs and installs renewable energy systems. Our offering includes photovoltaic systems, solar thermal systems, geothermal heating and cooling systems, and home energy performance consulting services. I started the company in 2002, and today we employ 23 people and are based in Rhinebeck, Dutchess County, New York.

Approximately 80% of our business is in Central Hudson territory. While we applaud the overall intention of promoting energy efficiency, Central Hudson's proposal could have a dramatic impact on our market, business and employment. Therefore we request that:

1. Hudson Valley Clean Energy, Inc. be an active party to the case and be allowed to comment on it, and,
2. That a case of this magnitude not be given expeditious review as requested by the applicant so as to allow interested parties sufficient time to understand its implications, comment on it, and suggest modifications.
