New York State Electric & Gas Corporation (NYSEG)

NYSEG has filed tariff revisions with the New York State Public Service Commission (PSC) for new electricity and natural gas delivery rates to become effective September 1, 2011. These tariff revisions cover the second of three annual delivery rate increases under the terms of a 40-month rate plan approved by the PSC in September 2010 and they include a \$27.8 million increase in electricity revenue and a \$2.4 million increase in natural gas revenue. The natural gas revenue increase reflects the removal of costs associated with the sale of the Seneca gas storage facility approved by the Commission earlier this year.

A residential electricity customer with an average use of 600 kilowatt-hours/month can expect an average monthly bill increase of \$1.34. A residential natural gas heating customer using 1,043 therms/year can expect an average monthly bill increase of \$1.49.

Customers may see some charges prorated on a September or October bill to take into account energy delivered before and after the new electricity and natural gas delivery rates went into effect.

RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMERS

Regular Residential Customers: The electricity delivery charge will increase 0.12 cents per kilowatt-hour. The per-therm natural gas delivery charge for the 4-to-50-therms block will increase 3.96 cents per therm. There are no changes to monthly customer or minimum charges.

Day/Night and Time-of-Use Customers: The electricity delivery charge will increase 0.10 cents per kilowatt-hour for Service Class 8 and 0.09 cents per kilowatt-hour for Service Class 12. There are no changes to monthly customer charges.

Rochester Gas and Electric Corporation (RG&E)

RG&E has filed tariff revisions with the New York State Public Service Commission (PSC) for new electricity and natural gas delivery rates to become effective September 1, 2011. These tariff revisions cover the second of three annual increases under the terms of a 40-month rate plan approved by the PSC in September 2010 and they include a \$10.2 million increase in electricity revenue and a \$10.9 million increase in natural gas revenue.

A residential electricity customer with an average use of 600 kilowatt-hours/month can expect an average monthly bill increase of \$1.11. A residential natural gas heating customer using 952 therms/year can expect an average monthly bill increase of \$2.46.

Customers may see some charges prorated on a September or October bill to take into account energy delivered before and after the new electricity and natural gas delivery rates went into effect.

RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMERS

Regular Residential Customers: The electricity energy charge for delivery increased by 0.182 cents per kilowatt-hour. Increases to the natural gas block rates are: 4 to 100 therms: 3.206 cents per therm; 101 to 500: 2.99 cents; 501 to 1,000: 2.644 cents; over 1,000: 0.975 cents. There are no changes to monthly customer or minimum charges.

Residential Time-of-Use Customers: The electricity energy charge for delivery for Service Classification 4 (Schedule I and II) increased by 0.16 cents per kilowatt-hour. There are no changes to monthly customer charges.


